

UNUSUALLY COLOURED GREASE PROVIDES UNUSUALLY GOOD RESULTS

The first surprise you get with this new grease from long-standing Spanish lubrication firm, Brugarolas, is its very bright green colour. But don't let that put you off... it's also surprising a growing number of contractors with its performance and value.

One such contractor is MACA (Mining and Civil Australia), who have just moved into their new premises in Ewing Street Welshpool, and are now carrying Aurea EH 2 in bulk, on-site, with their brand new lube truck.

Operations Manager and part-owner Geoff Baker is known for not doing things by halves or 'on the cheap'. Whilst his company is relatively new, he insists on amassing the best available machinery, support vehicles, premises and staff. "It's the same with our suppliers" he says.

"We're just not interested in dealing with people who don't understand the partnership thing. If we're putting our necks on the line for customers and paying good money for a supplier's product or service, we expect and demand the same performance as you would from your own business partner" he added. "I had been dealing with Karl Hofmann's team at ETS for a number of years, and was pretty happy with most of the lubrication products and support services we got. This Aurea EH 2 green grease was definitely one of the best we used. From a value-for-money viewpoint it stacks up pretty well. But when you get to see its performance and how well it sticks, even on gear working in blistering hot mine-sites, you really see it's value" he commented.

Technically-speaking it has a high base oil viscosity of 800 cSt @40C which improves adherence and sealing qualities required by heavy earthmoving equipment. It is based on Lithium – Calcium soap with highly refined mineral oils and special polymers, along with high performance additives.

Aurea EH 2 has been designed to lubricate mechanisms submitted to high shock loads and in centralised lube systems, preventing metal to metal contact and therefore reducing friction and wear.

There is no heavy metal content in Aurea EH 2 (Lead, barium, antimony and chlorine) which addresses safety and environmental issues. ETS (Equipment Technology Services Pty Ltd) are sole distributors for Australia and offer the grease in bulk tanks, drums, pails and cartridges if required.
